

Annual Report of NSS unit of VGC Mandi



1. International Yoga day was organised on 21 June 2018 in which 30 volunteers of NSS and other students of college actively participated and learnt the importance of yoga in life.



2. Tree plantation drive with forest Department in "Farsha "village was organized on 3 July 2018 and about 1000 trees were planted by 15 NSS volunteers accompanied by many other students, dignitaries and NSS officer Dr. Deepali Ashok and Dr. Tek Singh kapoor.



3. 2Shahdi Divas on Seri Manch (Main Market of Mandi Town) on 26 July 2018 was organised by D.C. Office, in which 35 students went to seri Manch and meet families of soldiers who lost their life during kargil war. In this program dignitaries like Panchayat minister Anil Thakur and ex service man were invited.

6. Campus cleaning, painting and green house plantation was organized in VGC campus from 5 to 7 Sep 2018. The volunteers of NSS cleaned the college campus and painted, Planted Green house of Botany under the guidance of NSS officer Dr. Deepali Ashok.







7. Kerala relief fund of Rs. 3130 was collected from 14-16th August 2018. Students took this as a social awareness program and asked for donation so that the people who suffered in Kerala were provided with food and shelter.

8. Volunteers made an accommodation committee (25 Volunteers) for badminton championship that was held from 2- 7 Oct 2018. It was inter college program in which many teams participated from all over Himachal. In this program NSS students played there important role in accommodation committee.

9. Awareness program on blood donation by red Cross of Mandi hospital (with Dr. Arvinder Roy) was organised. In this program students were encouraged to donate blood and we're told about benefits of blood donation. (38 Volunteers)



10. Fire safety mock drill was organized in VGC Mandi on 11 October 2018. This was very useful program as students learned how to protect themselves and others during natural disasters. (45 Volunteers).
