Library

The library of VGC Mandi caters to the needs of thousands of students studying in this prestigious institute. Around 38275 valuable books on various subjects, 12 daily newspapers, 22 monthly magazines and 12 journals are available in the college library. It is enlisted with INFLIBNET and National Digital Library. Keeping in view the interest of students, books are purchased for the library every year.

IGNOU (Indira Gandhi National Open University)

The college has a study centre of IGNOU, which was started in the year 1986. The centre has approximately 5000 registrations in the current session. Dr. Raj Kumar Thakur is serving as the Co-ordinator and Prof. Mahender Singh as the Assistant Co-ordinator of the centre. The centre runs a variety of academic and professional courses and has received appreciation for its working from the IGNOU Delhi Headquarters.

Post Office, Bank & Bus Pass Facility

The college houses the counters of post office and bus pass. Bank facility is also available in the college campus.

Co-Curricular Activities

National Service Scheme (NSS)

There are two units of National Service Scheme (NSS) in this college with a total enrolment of 200 volunteers in the current session. These units are working under the able guidance of two competent programme officers, Dr. Deepali Ashok and Prof. Suraj Mani. These volunteers are engaged in regular as well as special camp activities like literacy campaign, environmental protection, health awareness and cleanliness drives. Some of the activities carried out by the college NSS volunteers were as follows:

- ➤ World Environment Day was celebrated on 05 June 2023 to spread the message, 'Beat Plastic Pollution'.
- International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21 June 2023 in collaboration with District Administration Mandi with the theme 'Yoga for Vasudaiva Kutumbakam' (yoga for the welfare of all).
- ➤ Van Mahotsav week was observed from 01 July to 07 July 2023. The objective of this one-week long drive was to increase the green cover and to sensitise the volunteers about the importance of plants.
- ➤ 'Meri mati mera desh' campaign was organized in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra. On 09 August 2023, 144 NSS Volunteers participated in a rally on this initiative. A district level programme was held on 12 October 2023 and District Youth Festival was celebrated on 21 October 2023 in which the Chief Guest, Mr. Anurag Thakur (Union Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports) administered the Panch Pran Pledge to all the participants.
- ➤ Independence Day was celebrated on 15 August 2023. 130 volunteers celebrated the theme of 'Nation First, Always First'.
- Swachhta Rally was organized on 16 September 2023 in collaboration with Municipal Corporation Mandi to spread public awareness about cleanliness.
- ➤ District level Republic Day Selection Camp for women was organized and hosted by the college NSS unit on 21 September 2023.
- NSS Foundation Day was celebrated on 24 September 2023 with the theme of 'SEWA' (Social Empowerment and Welfare of All).
- ➤ Gandhi Jayanti was observed on 02 October 2023 by the NSS volunteers and District Administration of Mandi. The theme of this event was 'Ek Tareekh Ek Ghanta Ek Saath', that urged for one hour of citizen-led shramdaan for cleanliness/swachhta.
- Six Volunteers participated in State Pre-RD Camp 2023-2024 held at GC Bilaspur on 11 October 2023. In this camp Ms. Khushi was selected to attend the Pre-Republic Day camp at M.M. College Fatehabad (Haryana) from 24 October to 03 November 2023.
- NSS units and NCC wings of the college celebrated the National Unity Day on 31 October 2023 under the theme of 'Unity is Strength'.
- > To put the concept of 'Best out of Waste' into practice, an NSS garden was constructed in the college campus from 07 November to 10 November 2023 using waste plastic bottles and rubber tyres'.
- Heal Mother Suketi', a weeklong cleanliness drive was carried out by the NSS unit of the college from 27 November to 04 December 2023 to clean the Suketi river of Mandi. NSS volunteers cleaned the land on both sides of the river from Rani Bai to Panchvaktra temple, Mandi (a stretch of about 6 kilometres). ECO club and NCC wings of the college, Seraj Student Welfare Association Mandi along with other youth clubs and Municipal Corporation Mandi also helped the NSS unit in this initiative. Around 15 tons of plastic and other waste was collected by the end of this drive.

- ➤ Human Rights' Day was celebrated on 10 December 2023. The theme of the event was 'Freedom, Equality and Justice for All'.
- A seven-day special camp was organised from 30 December to 05 January 2024. The theme of this camp was 'स्वच्छता ही सेवा'.
- > On 17 February 2024, an excursion and trekking trip to Parasher Lake was organised.

Achievements of NSS unit:

- Ms Khushi, B.A. III year, participated in Republic Day Parade 2024 at New Delhi. She stood second in command during the parade at Kartavya Path and led the Women NSS Unit of India.
- National Youth Festival was held at Nasik (Maharashtra) from 12 October to 18 January 2024. Three Volunteers; Lucky Chauhan, Roop Singh and Neha Devi participated in it, whereas, Roop Singh represented Himachal Pradesh in this youth festival.
- National Adventure Camp was held at Pong dam, Talwara (Kangra) from 01January to 10 February 2024. Four Volunteers from NSS Mandi unit; Sakshi Sharma, Leena Sharma, Himanshu Palsara and Bhashik Rana participated in this camp.
- Six NSS Volunteers; Vijay Kumar, Lucky Singh, Roop Singh, Garima Thakur, Neha Devi and Kalpana participated in State level NSS Mega Camp 2023-24 at GC Banjar, held from 18 December to 22 December 2023.

National Cadet Corps (NCC):

The **c**ollege is proud to have three wings of NCC: Army wing (Girls), Army wing (Boys) and Air Force wing (Girls and boys).

NCC Air Force Wing:

NCC Air Force Wing of the college is being run under the command of Flight Commander Associate NCC Flying Officer, Dr Chaman Lal. Under his able leadership the college NCC Air wing was made a permanent unit. 38 girl cadets and 62 boy cadets got enrolled in the Air Force Wing in the session 2023-24.

- Cadet Warrant Officers Ajay Kumar and Santosh Kumar, Under Officer Virendra Chandel and Senior Under Officer Angad Singh of NCC Air Wing received President's Commission and became Flying Officers in the Indian Air Force.
- Cadet Mohit Verma and Under Officer Simran Malhotra qualified the Air Force Common Admission Test (AFCAT) and got recommended from Service Selection Board Gandhinagar and Service Selection Board Allahabad.
- Recently, four other cadets were also recommended by the Service Selection Board, Allahabad for the Short Service Selection category under the NCC Entry Scheme. It is a matter of great pride us.
- ➤ 14 NCC Air wing cadets qualified NCC "CEE" Certificate examination in current training Year 2023-2024.
- Many capable cadets of this unit participated in various air-force /army camps throughout the country.
- Cadet Sergeant Kartik Thakur of National Cadet Corps Air Force Wing Mandi participated

- in the National Republic Day Parade (Delhi) 2024. Cadet Sergeant Kartik Thakur was selected in the All-India Best Cadet category.
- NCC Air wing of the college tirelessly helped the flash flood hit areas in the month of August, 2023 by collaborating with Indian Air Force. Apart from this, the NCC air wing was also involved in tree plantation at Kangni Dhar and Dhangsi Dhar and Suketi Khad cleanliness drive.

NCCArmy Wing (Boys):

Major (Dr.) Chetan Singh Rana commanded the NCC Army wing until his superannuation in June 2023. Thereafter, Dr. Balbir Singh took over as CTO of NCC Army (Boys) wing. This unit enrolled 110 cadets during the session 2023-24 including 95 SD cadets and 15 SW cadets.

- Cadet Sanjay was appointed as SUO (Student Under Officer), while cadets Hitesh Kumar and Rohan Baner were appointed as UOs (Under Officers) in the rank ceremony.
- A total of 34 cadets successfully obtained the "BEE" certificate, and 30 cadets cleared the "CEE" certificate examination.
- ➤ Cadets from VGC, Mandi participated in the Thal Sainik Camp at Solan from 28 July to 06 August 2023. Two of these cadets were selected for the Inter Group Competition at Ropar, Punjab from 07 August to 16 August. Cadet Aditya Bist participated in this camp.
- ➤ 33 cadets of Boys Army wing participated in the Annual Training Camp at 239 Transit Camp, Pandoh (Mandi) from 28 November to 07 December 2023.
- ➤ 15 third-year cadets also participated in the Army Attachment Camp at Mamun Cantt, Pathankot (Punjab) from 11 December to 22 December 2023.
- NCC cadets of this unit were also engaged in various activities throughout the year, like: International Yoga Day, Kargil Vijay Diwas, Meri Matti Mera Desh Programme, Tree Plantation, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, National Unity Day, NCC Day, Republic Day and National Women's Day.
- A special session on motivation and career guidance for NCC cadets was also organized by this unit. In this session cadets were informed about the role of NCC, SSB selection process and Officer entry in the Indian Army.

NCC Army Wing (Girls):

NCC Army Wing (Girls) of the college is being run under the leadership of Dr. Kavita. 75 SW cadets were enrolled in this wing during the current session.

- ≥ 25 cadets of third year successfully obtained the "BEE" certificate in 2023.
- Student under Officer, Dhriti Sharma received the awards of Best Cadet and best drill at District level. She also attended a national camp at Army Attachment Camp Pathankot. SUO Dhriti is also a District Level Contingent Commander.
- ➤ Under Officer, Ishani attended a National Camp Shooting competition at Chandigarh and finished first as the best shooter of the competition.
- NCC Army wing organized a lecture to spread awareness about G-20 on 28 February, 2023. This unit also organized a debate and quiz competition about G-20 on 11 March, 2023.
- NCC Army (Girls) unit celebrated various important days in the session 2023-24, such as:

- International Yoga Day, International Day against Drug Abuse, NCC Day, International AIDS Day, and Women's Day.
- Cadets of this wing also participated in public awareness drives and campaigns: Garbage Free India, Indian Swachhta League 2.0, Swachhta Pakhwada and Anti-Pollution drive.
- ➤ Cadets of NCC (Girls) Army wing of the college also took oath on 20 May 2023 as a part of 'Mission Lifestyle for Environment'. A poster making competition was organised on this mass movement to protect environment.

Red Cross Club:

Dr. Chaman Lal, is the programme officer of the Youth Red Cross Club in the college. The main objective of this club is to protect life and health and to ensure respect for the human being.

- ➤ Kartik Sen and Himanshu Vardhan of B.Sc. II Year voluntarily donated blood in emergencies at Zonal Hospital Mandi.
- ➤ Eighty (80) members of the Red Cross club underwent a training programme on 'First –aid during Disasters' on 01 November 2023.
- This club collected funds for red cross by selling red cross tickets and by collecting membership fees from its enrolled members.

Red Ribbon Club:

Dr. Radhika Jamwal, is the programme officer of Red Ribbon Club in the college and has been leading the club with great enthusiasm.

- To spread awareness about AIDS in the district, the Red Ribbon Club of our college hosted the 'Red Run Marathon' and 'The Red Show Abhivyakti' on 20 September 2023. A marathon and a skit competition were organised on the occasion in which 10 colleges of district Mandi participated. Rohit and Mansi from VGC Mandi won the marathon in the Men and Women category and represented district Mandi at State level 'Red Run' competition, organized by Himachal Pradesh AIDS Control Society, Shimla on 01 October 2023. Rohit from B.A. I year won this marathon and was selected to participate in 'National Red Run' marathon at Panjim (Goa). The college stood second in 'The Red Show Abhivyakti' competition at district level.
- The club received the 'Best Red Ribbon Club' award in the state. This award was received by Dr. Radhika Jamwal from the Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh Sh. Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu on 01 December 2023 at Shimla.
- On 08 December 2023, volunteers from this club performed 'nukad natak' at different places of Mandi town to sensitise the public and students about AIDS.
