<u>Curriculum planning and delivery of Chemistry Department for the</u> <u>Session 2023-2024</u>

August

(a)Commencement of classes - Classes commence during the month of August with introductory sessions conducted during the initial days to familiarize the students with the syllabus and the credits for each paper. WhatsApp groups for the students of each class are created by the teachers to remain in constant touch with their respective classes. During the early days of classes, teachers with the feedback from students reassess and recalibrate their teaching methodologies in accordance with the needs of the students.

(b)Practical classes begin post the creation of practical groups –Student Groups for performing the practical work in labs are created during the second week of classes and regular labs commence by the third week.

(c) **Target to complete Syllabus -** Approximately 20% of the syllabus is completed by the end of the month.

(d) Student leaders for the Mendeleev Chemistry Club are selected to carry out the club activities for the rest of the academic year.

September

The regular teaching and practical work continues and by end of month approximately 40% of the syllabus is completed. Through the month assignments/seminars/class tests are conducted for the CCA(Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment) of students. To celebrate Ozone day on 16th Sept. various activities by Mendeleev Chemistry Club may be conducted.

October

The regular teaching and practical work continues and by end of month approximately 60% of the syllabus is completed. Through the month assignments/seminars/class tests are conducted for the CCA (Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment) of students. Special events may be conducted on the occasion of the Mole Day on the 23rd of October.

November

Special events may be conducted on the occasion of the World Science Day on the 10th of November. The paper setting work of mid-term exams is completed by mid-month and the syllabus and pattern of the same is shared with the students. Approximately 80% is completed by the end of month.

December

Revision classes for mid-term examinations are conducted during the first week of the month. The mid-term exam commence by the second week.

1st January-5th February College closes for winter vacations.

Assignments are given to the students for vacation period.

February

College reopens after holidays on 5th or 6th February. The assessed mid-term answer sheets are shared with the respective students and their feedback taken. The students who could not take their mid-term exams in December due to some genuine reasons, are given the opportunity to take their exams in February. Special events may be conducted on the occasion of the National Science Day on the 28th of February. 100% syllabus is completed by the end of month and the student CCA is completed.

March

During first week revision classes are conducted and final practical exams begin from the second week of the month.

April

University conducts end term exams.
