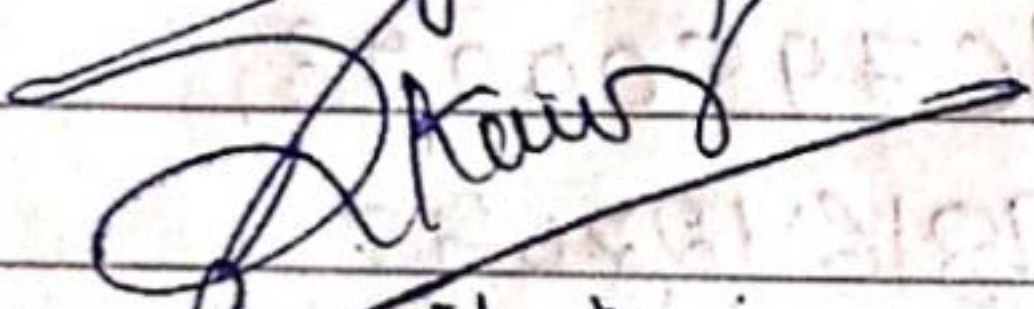
Following resolutions were passed for the benefit of the students and the college community :-

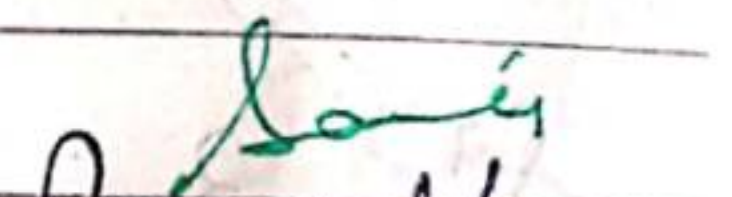
⇒ for unforeseen expenses an amount of Rs. Two Lakh was approved.

⇒ Amount of Rs. One Lakh was approved for hiring part-time coaches for different sports during inter-college sports competitions.

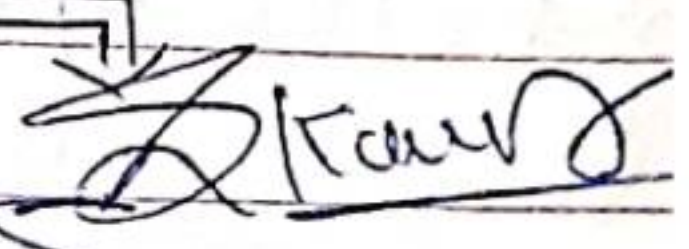
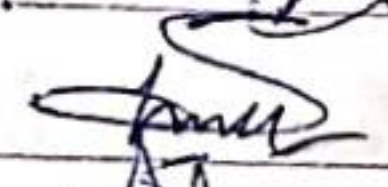
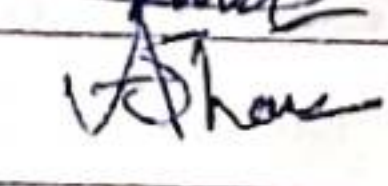
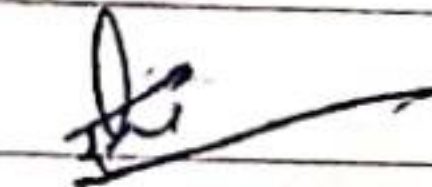
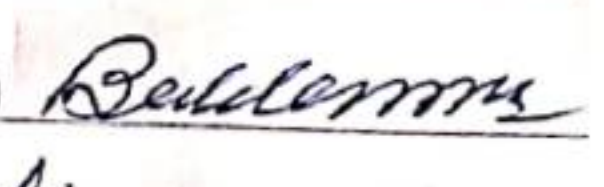
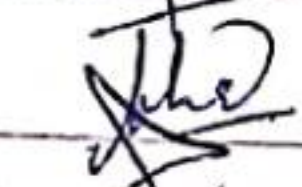

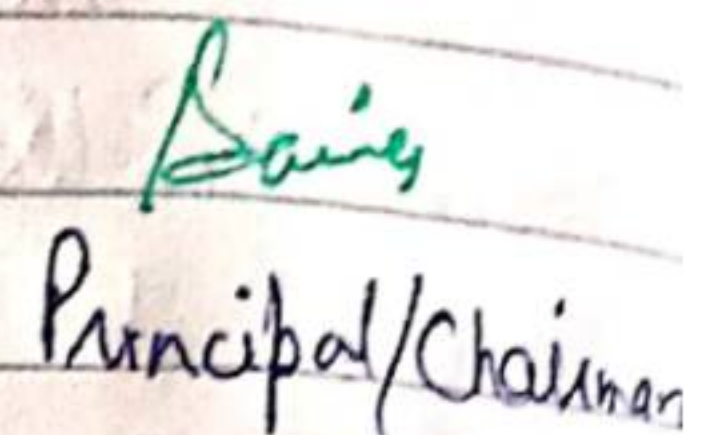
Following resolutions were presented and passed unanimously:-

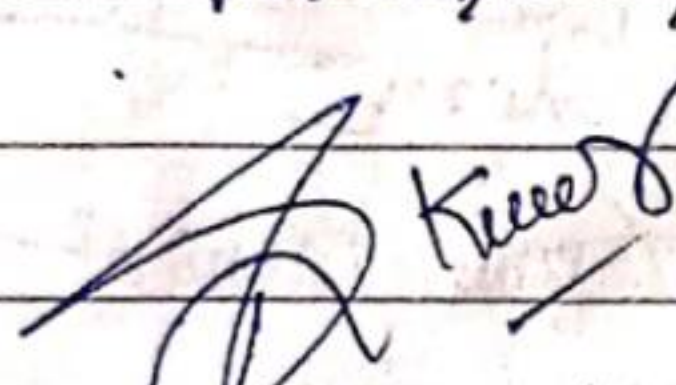
Following resolutions were passed in the meeting:

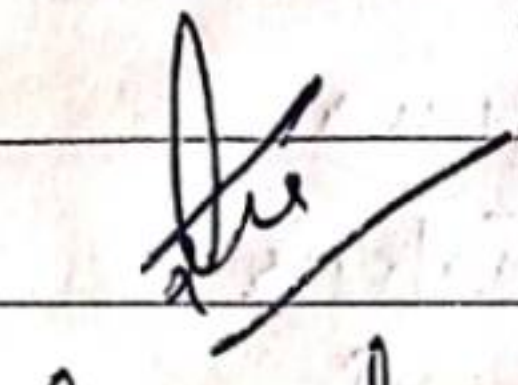

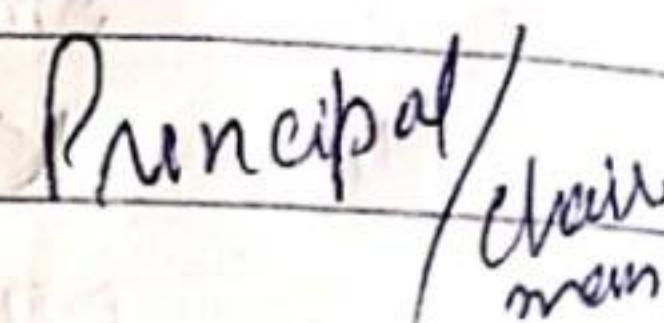
— PTA executive body decided to contribute for infrastructural development of the college. For this an amount of ₹ 50,000/- was approved / sanctioned for creating smart
