A REPORT

The annual athletic meet of Vallabh Government College Mandi was held on 8-9 November 2024 at Paddal Ground, Mandi. The event began on 8 November 2024 at 9:30 a.m. with the assembly of students of the college in the Paddal Ground. Registration for various events began at 9:30 am at the registration desk near the pavilion. The chief guest of the occasion, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Sardar Patel University, Prof. Lalit Kumar Awasthi, arrived at 11 a.m. He was accompanied by the Controller of Examination, Prof. Sunil Verma. They were greeted warmly by the Principal, staff, and all the students present in the ground.

The march-past ceremony marked the beginning of the athletic meet. The college students were divided into twenty-five contingent groups based on classes, clubs, and units. Each group was led by a flag bearer. Taran Preet Singh Gill, the college sports captain, led the march past, bearing the college flag. He was followed by the college units of NCC Army Boys Wing, Army Girls Wing, Air Force Wing, NSS, Rovers and Rangers, students of various classes, and the last group comprised of students from the Department of Physical Education. It was a beautiful synchronization of the steps. The ground wore a festive look with all the sports enthusiasts.



The chief guest was felicitated with a Himachali cap and a muffler by the Principal, Prof. Sureena Sharma, as a token of our culture. The Principal also felicitated Prof. Sunil Verma. After that, Prof. Surina Sharma gave her welcome address, highlighting the value of sports in our lives. She also stressed the fact that sports teach ethics and values to the students, which are essential for fair play and sportsmanship. This was followed by the address of the chief guest. He also

reiterated the fact that sports teach us a lot in our lives, mainly to excel and cope with failures. He congratulated the Principal and the staff members for giving ample opportunities to the students in sports. He, thereafter, declared "the college Annual Athletics Meet 2024 open". For the flag hoisting ceremony, the chief guest and the other guests were led by the principal, the convener of the event, the organizing secretary, and the game presidents to the flag post. The chief guest hoisted the flag.

The Sacred Torch was carried into the ground by Ms Mansi Thakur and Mr Rohit, athletes from the Department of Physical Education. After the arrival of the sacred torch, the students were administered the Athletes' Oath by Captain Taran Preet Singh, in which they pledged to respect and abide by the rules of Athletics and the college. Dr. Ravinder Kumar, the convener of the event, proposed a vote of thanks.

After the inaugural function, the competitive events began. The first event was 100 m Heats in the Men's category, in which 42 athletes contested. This was followed by the heat round in 100 m (women), 400 m (men), and 400m (women) in which 15, 37, and 09 athletes participated respectively. This was followed by the final rounds of Shot Put(women), High Jump(men), Shot Put (men), Javelin Throw(men), and women in which 19,7,6 and 10 athletes participated. The Final rounds of 800m (men), 800 (women), long jump(men) Discuss (women), 100m (women), 100 m (men), 400 m (women), and 400m(men) were also held and the winners for the same were as follows. Kanika Thakur of B.Sc III year bagged the first position in 100 meters, Roshani bagged the second position and Kavita Thakur won the third position. In 400 meters(women) Kanika Thakur won the first position, Ritika secured the second position and Kavita Thakur secured the third position. In 800 meters(women) Roshani secured the first position, Kavita Thakur won the second position and Nisha secured the third position. In the 100 meters(men), Dixit Prashar secured the first position, Nitesh Kumar won the second position and the third position was bagged by Uday Chauhan. In the 400 meters(men) Bhulesh Kumar won the first position, Chetan Kumar Atal won the second position, and Lal Singh with Kabir Singh both bagged the third position. In the 800 meters (men), Pratham secured the first position, Aryan Thakur secured the second position and the third position was bagged by Bhavan Kumar. In Shot Put(men), Siddharth came first, Rahul stood second and Anshul came third.

The second day of the Annual Athletic Meet started with great enthusiasm shown by the audience and the participants. Dr Hemraj Rana and Dr. Banita Saklani coordinated all the events brilliantly, both as anchors and commentators. On this day, all the committees efficiently conducted the final rounds of the various sports competitions, such as Men's and Women's 200 m

race, 1500 m race, High Jump, Discuss Throw, Javelin Throw, Shot Put, Women's Long Jump, etc as per the schedule and the final list of winners was handed over to the prize presentation committee to be declared during the closing ceremony. The final list of winners was as follows:

In the 200 m race (men), Rohit secured first position, Latesh took second and Upendra got third place. In the Long Jump(women), Hemlata earned first place, Kavita Thakur got second and Chetna Kumari took third position. In the High Jump(women), Sarita secured first place, Purna came second and Kavita finished third. In Discus Throw(women), Sakshi secured first place, Sania got second and Hemlata took third place. In the 200 m race (women), Purna secured first position, Kavita bagged second and Chetna bagged third. In the Shot Put(women), Sakshi claimed first place, Shivani got second and Saniya finished third. In the Javelin Throw(women), Sakshi earned first place, Kanika Sharma took second and Shivani got third position.

In the 100 m race (teaching staff, female), Prof. Aditi claimed first place, Dr. Madhavi secured second and Dr. Bandana got third place. In the 100 m race (non-teaching staff females), Mrs. Hansa Devi claimed first place, Mrs. Lata Devi took second and Mrs. Ruma Devi got third place. In the High Jump (teaching male staff), Prof. Vijay Kumar secured first place, Prof. Arvind Kumar got second and Prof Chooda Mani claimed third place. In the Musical Chair competition (female teaching staff), Prof. Aditi secured first place, Prof. Bipasha got second and Prof. Anju Bala took third place.

Post lunch session began with the grand event of the Closing Ceremony. Professor Padam Singh Guleria, former Principal, Maharaja Lakshman Sen Memorial College Sunder Nagar presided over the function as the chief guest. Major Man Singh Jamwal (Retd.) former Principal Vallabh Government College Mandi was the other distinguished guest who graced this occasion. Professor Surina Sharma, Principal, Vallabh Govt. College Mandi, the entire college staff, NCC volunteers, athletes, and students welcomed all the eminent guests and escorted them onto the stage. Dr Banita Saklani, President, of HGCTA, formally welcomed the chief guest. Professor Padam Singh, a very renowned and eminent personality presently serving as Sr. Vice-President of the Indian Kayaking and Canoeing Association and General Secretary of Himachal Pradesh Kayaking and Canoeing Association. He has raised the standard and status of sports in our state. He has also been a recipient of Him Gaurav Puraskar. Some of the main events such as, the men's 1500 m race and Tug of War were conducted in front of the guests. In an exciting Men's 1500 m race competition, Shashi Thakur bagged first place, Rahul secured second and Rohan got third position. In a tug-of-war competition, the academic staff defeated the non-academic staff. In another tug-of-war competition held between college staff and students, the students won with a score of 2-1 defeating the college staff in both the male and female categories. Our distinguished guests and audiences enjoyed all these fun events immensely through which our college staff displayed a great sense of sportsman spirit. Refreshment was also served to all the guests, staff, and participants during this event. After that, the Principal honoured the chief guest, Professor Padam Singh Guleria and Professor Man Singh Jamwal with our traditional Himachali topi and shawl and also presented mementos as a token of love and respect. Then Dr Sanjay Thakur, Game President, presented a brief report of this two-day Annual Athletic Meet 2024-25.

CSCA Cultural Function 2024

A Report

A two-day CSCA cultural function 'UTSAV' was organized in Vallabh Government College Mandi (H.P.) w.e.f. 27 November 2024 to 28 November 2024 in the college auditorium. It was being organized after a long span of 12 years which made the event more wonderful, piquing and enthralling. Many competitions were held in this cultural bonanza. The participants had to go through auditions for all the competitions as per the norms and conditions laid down by the organizing committee. The auditions of students were conducted by the committee members between 15 to 20 November 2024. The selected participants in the auditions were allowed to take part in the final CSCA Utsav 2024. About 300 students of the college auditioned for the competitions, out of which about 100 students were selected who displayed their expertise in a particular item.

The programme on the first day began with the arrival of the chief guest and other distinguished guests. Prof. Ramesh Ravi, retired Principal, Govt. College Paunta Sahib was the chief guest on the first day of Utsav. He inaugurated the function with the lighting of a lamp at 10:00 am. The students from the Music Department presented *Vande Mataram*. Thereafter, the Principal honoured the Chief Guest by presenting a memento and a Himachali cap and shawl. Subsequently, she welcomed the Chief Guest in her address and congratulated the teachers, members of the College Central Students Association (CSCA) and students for reviving this event after 12 years. Thereafter, Kirna the President of CSCA, gave a heartfelt welcome to the Chief Guest, teachers and all the students. The Chief Guest, in his speech, motivated the students to participate actively in cultural and sports activities along with studies.

The cultural competitions started with a *Bhajan* competition in which the students tried their best to excel each other in every possible way. The event enthused the heart of the audience with devotion as everyone visualized a gleaming aura around. After this, the students of the

music department presented an invigorating group folk dance. This was followed by a solo folk dance competition. On the heel of the group folk dance and solo folk dance, various other competitions like mimicry, solo bollywood song, solo folk song, semi-classical dance and solo bollywood dance were held respectively that marked the stunning performance.

The second day of the 'UTSAV' was inaugurated by esteemed retired Principal, Shukla Sharma, as the Chief Guest. *Saraswati Vandana* was presented by the students from the music department to seek the blessings and benignity of the goddess of learning and wisdom, Saraswati. The vice-president (CSCA), Smriti welcomed the Chief Guest, teachers and all the students. Taking the series of competitions forward, the first competition began with the charismatic presentations of semi-classical dance. In this sequence, other competitions took place one after the other such as solo folk song, group folk dance, traditional modelling, solo bollywood song, skit, mime, solo bollywood dance, solo folk dance and group folk dance competition. The participants of traditional modelling stole the show, it was not about contemporary fashion but it was a show of tradition and culture of India. A total of 26 contestants participated from different streams and classes. Some came donned with the traditional dresses representing the local cultures of Kullu, Shimla and Seraj. Others looked graceful in Kashmiri, Rajasthani, Bengali and Maharashtrian dresses. All in all, it was a glimpse of mini-India. Out of 26 contestants, 10 were selected for the semi-final round. These ten participants explained briefly about the attires they wore. It was a beautiful show of colours and five contestants were declared winners by the judges.

After the final performance of competitions in the cultural program— 'Utsav'—a prize distribution ceremony was held in which the winners of first, second and third positions were felicitated with trophies and certificates. Priyanka, Chandra Shekhar, and Krish were awarded first, second and third respectively in the solo folk song competition. Mukesh Raj was awarded first in the solo bhajan competition. Sahil Dogra, Ekta and Kusuma Devi were awarded first, second and third respectively in the solo ghazals competition. In the solo bollywood dance competition Bhavakshiti, Shweta and Naman bagged first, second and third positions respectively. Gagandeep Kaur, Harsh Lata and Kanu Priya were awarded first, second and third positions respectively in the solo folk dance competition. In the semi-classical dance competition, first, second and third prizes were bagged by Kashish, Ishu, Mahi, Jyoti and Kritika

respectively. Likewise, in the solo bollywood song competition, Banita, Vanshika Soni, and Payal bagged first, second, and third respectively. In the group folk dance competition, New Girl Hostel Group, Prachi & Group and Shweta & Group were placed first, second, and third respectively. The award for the best performance in skit was given to Pratibha and the award for the best performance in Mime was conferred on Kritika. The award for the best mimicry was given to Mohit. In the traditional modelling competition, the title of Miss Utsav 2024 was won by Shreya Bagga. Kashish was the first runner-up and Jyoti was the second runner-up. Miss Beautiful was Latasha Thakur and the title of Miss Best Dressed was conferred on Damini.

After the prize distribution ceremony, the Chief Guest, in her speech, congratulated and applauded the winners. She encouraged those who somehow missed to mark their presence through success and advised them not to feel disheartened rather they should work harder in future to outshine others. 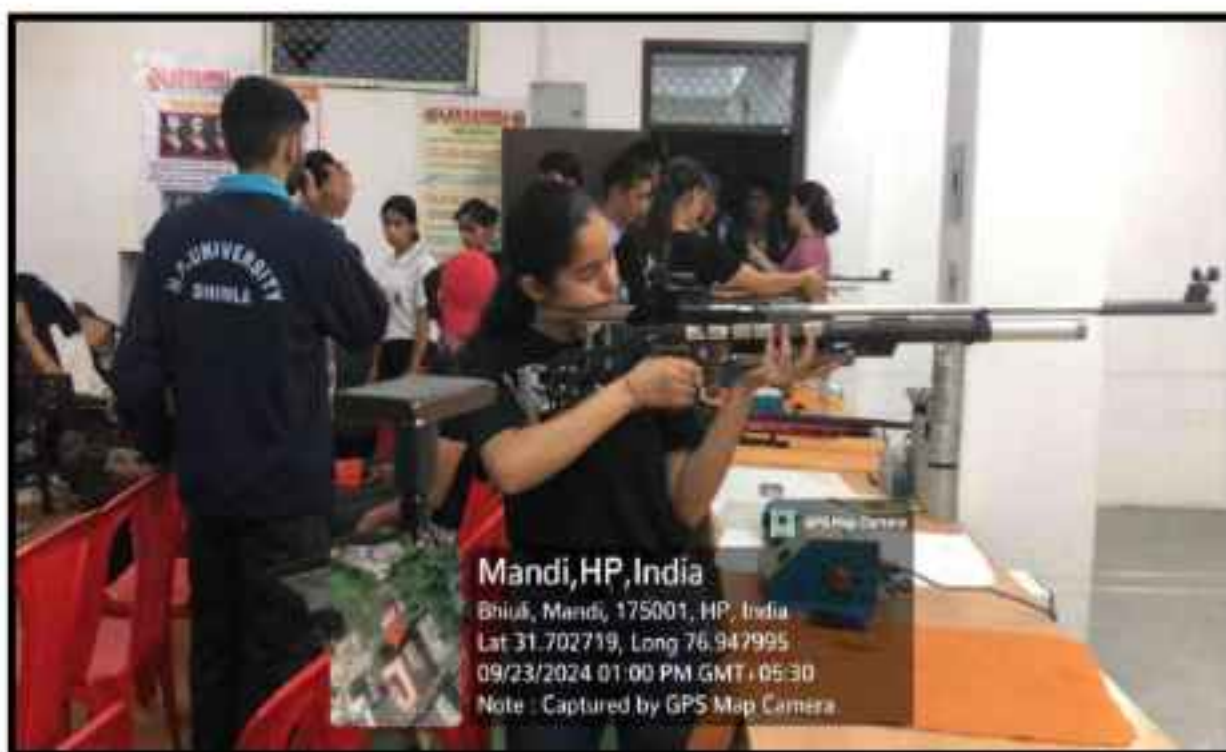
