The celebrations featured over 5,000 folk and tribal artists from across India, showcasing more than 50 traditional dance forms on Kartavya Path in New Delhi. This grand 11-minute cultural performance, organized by the Ministry of Culture & Sangeet Natak Akademi, celebrated themes such as *Viksit Bharat*, *Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat*, *Songs Jayati Jay Mam Bharatam* and was officially recognized by Guinness World Records.

A Report
