

Republic Day 26th January 2025 & Guinness World Records (Folk Dance) at Kartavya Path, Delhi

During the 76th Republic Day celebrations on January 26, 2025 Fifteen students under the guidance of **Dr. Santosh Kumar** of Vallabh Government College, Mandi, Himachal Pradesh participated in the 76th Republic Day celebrations on January 26, 2025. They set a Guinness World Record on January 24, 2025, for the largest Indian folk variety dance and later performed the same dance as part of the Republic Day parade on Kartavya Path at India Gate. The celebrations featured over 5,000 folk and tribal artists from across India, showcasing more than 50 traditional dance forms on Kartavya Path in New Delhi. This grand 11-minute cultural performance, organized by the Ministry of Culture & Sangeet Natak Akademi, celebrated themes such as *Viksit Bharat*, *Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat*, *Songs Jayati Jay Mam Bharatam* and was officially recognized by Guinness World Records.
